

Summary of Housing Need Groups



Group 1 Sheltered (aged over 55 only)	A (critical)	Hospitalised or if there's a danger in occupying current home
	B (urgent)	Housebound, medical condition being aggravated, cant access basic facilities
	C (general)	Would benefit from social aspects of sheltered
Group 2 Homeless	A (critical)	Referred by Inverclyde Council due to homelessness
Group 3 Unsatisfactory Housing Conditions	A (critical)	RCH tenants/owners affected by River Clyde Homes regeneration plans
	B (urgent)	Unsatisfactory housing conditions such as leaving supported accommodation, veterans, dis-repair, overcrowding, under occupation.
	C (general)	No legal housing need but aspiring to rent a home from River Clyde Homes
Group 4 Mobility Medical and Frail and Mobility Impaired	A (critical)	Hospitalised or if there's a danger in occupying current home
	B (urgent)	Housebound, medical condition being aggravated, cant access basic facilities
